Field trip option 1: Micronesian Starlings on Andersen Air Force Base

Head to Andersen Air Force Base to check out the Micronesian starling nest box project. Biologists will describe this latest effort to provide additional nesting areas for these birds, and explain some of the latest findings.

- Participation is limited to the first 20 registrants and U.S. citizens [If you are a Foreign National, the security office requires one-month lead time, so unfortunately you will not be able to participate in this tour.]
- View starling nesting boxes and visit the Tarague embayment area
- Saturday, 18 November, 2017
- 8:00 AM-to- 11:30 AM
- Meet at the Micronesian Mall at 7:30 AM outside the main Macy's entrance, and we will carpool to Andersen.

Your personal information will be submitted to the Andersen Air Force base security staff for vetting. On the day of the event we will stop briefly at the Visitor Control Center outside the gate and each participant will receive a pass to keep on their person throughout the tour. Since Guam driver's licenses are not REAL ID compliant (and some other states are not either), all participants should bring their passport with them. Without it, you will be turned away.

You will not be allowed to bring your own car on base unless you already have base access. We will carpool together in one of several vehicles.

We look forward to accompanying you on a brief tour of Andersen Air Force Base. We will focus on sites that are relevant to recent natural resource projects. We will visit some cultural sites as well.
